



Easy Tunisian Scarves



Materials:

1 Ball (100 g/200 m) Nashua Handknits Creative Focus
Worsted (85% wool/15% alpaca)
Size L/11 (8 mm) Easy Tunisian & P (15 mm) Standard
Crochet Hooks
Tapestry Needle

Stitches:

Tunisian Simple Stitch (TSS): Sk first vertical bar, insert hook under next vertical bar, yo, pull up lp, (insert under next vertical bar, yo, pull up lp) across. Do not turn. Work lps off: yo, pull through one lp on hook, (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) across until one lp remains on hook.

Tunisian Double Stitch (TDS): Ch 1, sk first vertical bar, (yo, insert hook under next vertical bar, yo, pull up lp, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook) across, leaving all lps on hook. Do not turn. Work lps off: yo, pull through one lp on hook, (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) across, leaving one lp on hook at end of row.

Directions: With Easy Tunisian hook, ch 16.

Row 1: Insert hook in second ch from hook, yo, pull up lp, (insert hook in next ch, yo, pull up lp) across, leaving all lps on hook. Do not turn.

Work lps off: yo, pull through one lp on hook, (yo, pull through 2 lps on hook) across until one lp remains on hook.

Row 2: TDS.

Row 3: TSS.

Repeat Rows 2-3 (49 times) for scarf.

Bind off: sk first vertical bar, * insert hook under next vertical bar, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook; repeat from * across. Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut 50 strands of yarn, 8-10 each. Using standard crochet hook and a larks head knot, attach 5 strands evenly across each short end of scarf.

Abbreviations Used (US Terminology):

lp/lps: loops sk: skip

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
